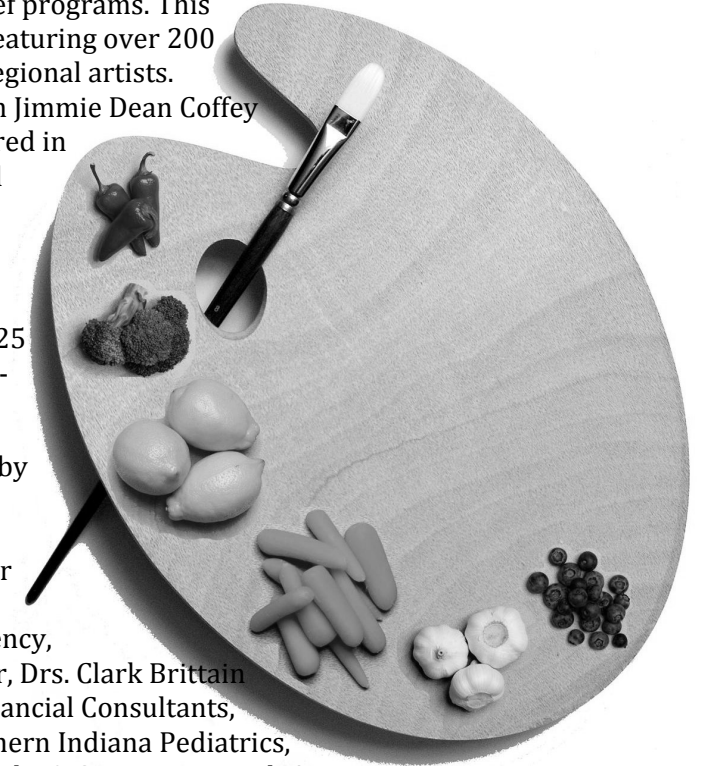
Saturday, May 21, 2011 • 6pm • Henke Hall of Champions (Memorial Stadium)
